KEY TO DESCRIPTIONS:

FD – Formal Decorative: Flat petals uniform and regularly arranged, curving toward stem.

ID – Informal Decorative: Petals twisted, curled or wavy, their arrangement irregular.

SC – Semi Cactus: Narrow petals rolled majority of their length.

C – Cactus: Narrow petals rolled majority of their length.

IC – Incurved Cactus: Same as Cactus except with a pronounced curvature of petals toward the center.

BA, MB, P: Ball's Min Balls, Poms: Blooms have a honeycomb appearance and are very round.

ST – Stellar: Petals are narrow and cupped recurving toward the stem.

WL – Waterlily: Petals flat to saucer-shaped. Four to seven rows of petals.

PE – Peony: Two or more rows of petals around an open center.

AN – Anemone: One or more rows of petals surrounding a center of elongated tubular florets.

CO – Collarette: Open-centered with single row of petals, small petaloids around a central disc.

S – Single: Open centered with single row of petals.

O – Orchid flowering: Open centered with single row of evenly spaced tube-like petals.

NX – Novelty: Closed centered flower which doesn't fit into any other class.

NO – Novelty: Open centered flower which doesn't fit into any other class.
